

## Lamar Community College CARES/CRRSAA Distribution Plan/Quarterly Report 07/06/2021

LCC acknowledges that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Upon receipt of the CRRSAA funding on (January 21, 2021) LCC determined a pay structure to accommodate exceptional need based on EFC from the FAFSA data on file. We used population reports and compiled the chart below based on EFC numbers using the same range as we do when we report our FISAP data.

We have \$113,461 left in CARES funding and combined it with the \$294,210 received in CRRSAA funding to pay all enrolled students based on the break down below. Concurrent Enrollment students are not included in this data.

274 students were eligible to receive funding. 274 students were paid funding based on the pay structure above.

Additionally, LCC awarded one-time funding to nursing students whose clinicals and labs were affected by pandemic restrictions to assist in the additional expenses for housing, childcare, and/or travel. Seven (7) students received \$250 due to one term only in clinicals and thirty (30) received \$500 for a total of \$16,750.

Remaining funding of \$19,671.00, after the awarding of students that met the criteria above, will be based on an application basis. If a student applied for additional funding after the disbursement then LCC will evaluate each one and award up to an additional \$1,000 per student.
