

## Lamar Community College CARES/CRRSAA Distribution Plan/Quarterly Report 10/05/2021

LCC acknowledges that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Upon receipt of the CRRSAA funding on (January 21, 2021) LCC determined a pay structure to accommodate exceptional need based on EFC from the FAFSA data on file. We used population reports and compiled the chart below based on EFC numbers using the same range as we do when we report our FISAP data.

We have paid all CARES funding in the amount of \$294,210. After spending funding based on the EFC chart supplied in the July 2021 report we determined that our Nursing program was in high need due to the required clinicals and the additional costs for personal protective gear due to COVID.

We awarded all nursing students who were enrolled in clinicals \$250 for one Semester of clinicals and \$500 for 2 Semesters. The total amount spend for this campaign was \$5750.

As of October 1, 2021 we have spent \$276,539 of our allocated CRRSAA funding. We were able to award 224 students based on the EFC chart and the Nursing campaign.

Remaining funding of \$17,671.00, after the awarding of students that met the criteria above, will be awarded based on applications received or added to the ARP funding received for bulk award during the Fall of 2021.
