

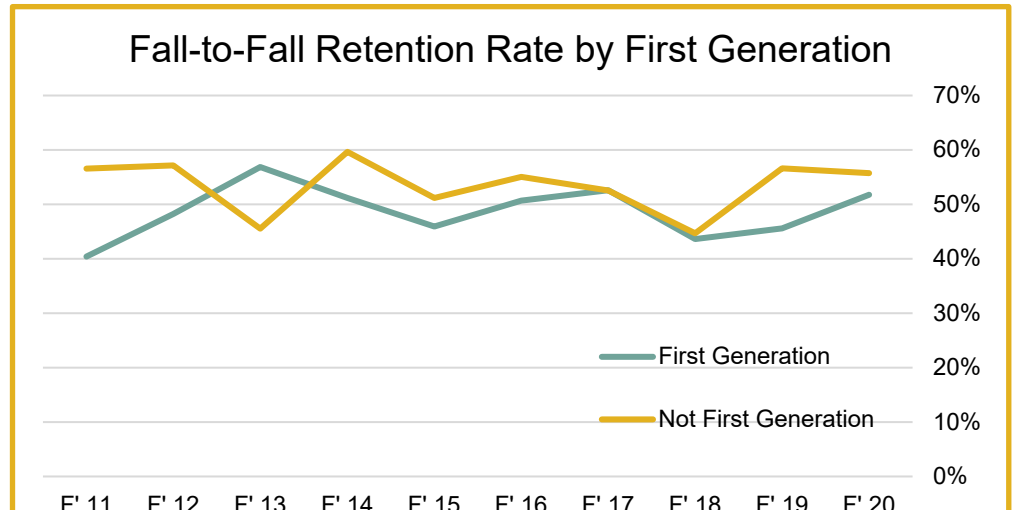
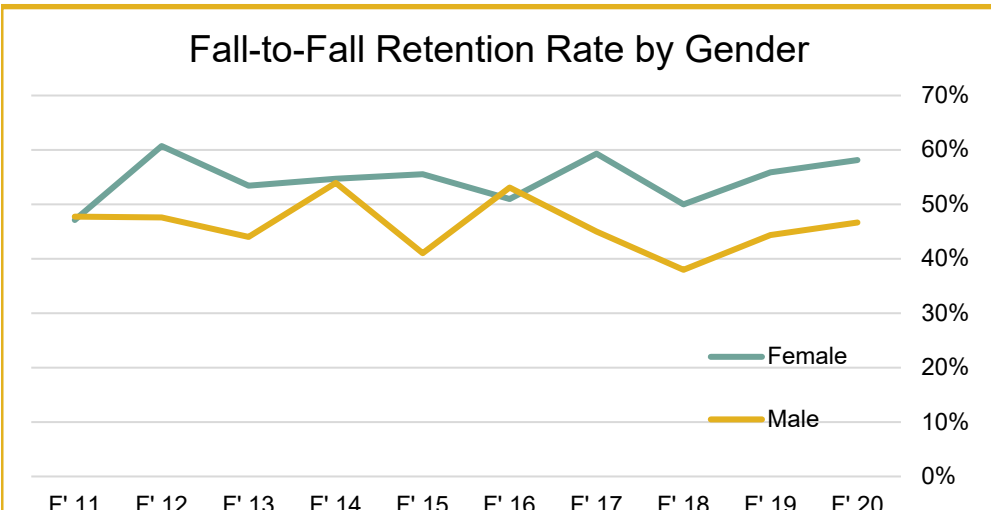
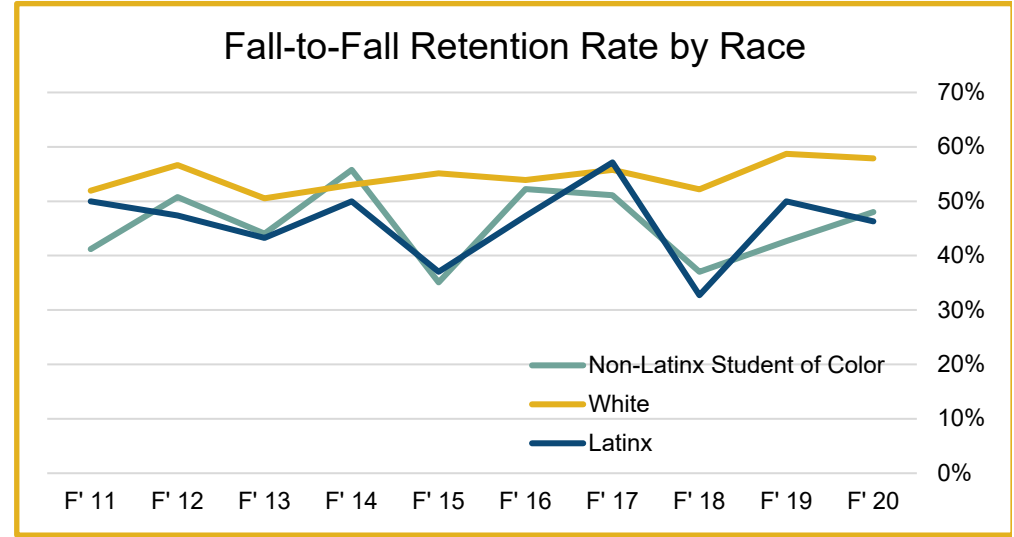
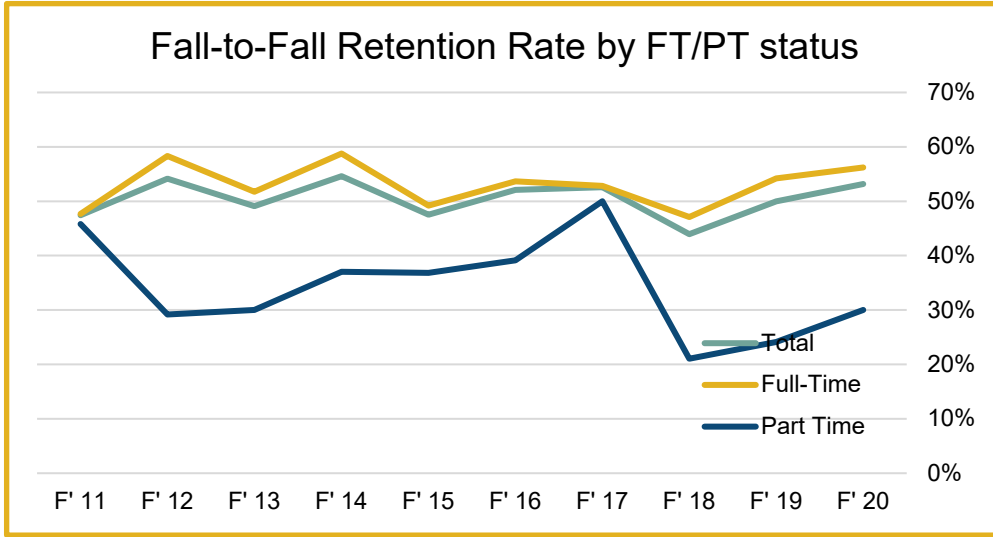
Retention, Graduation, and Transfer Rates

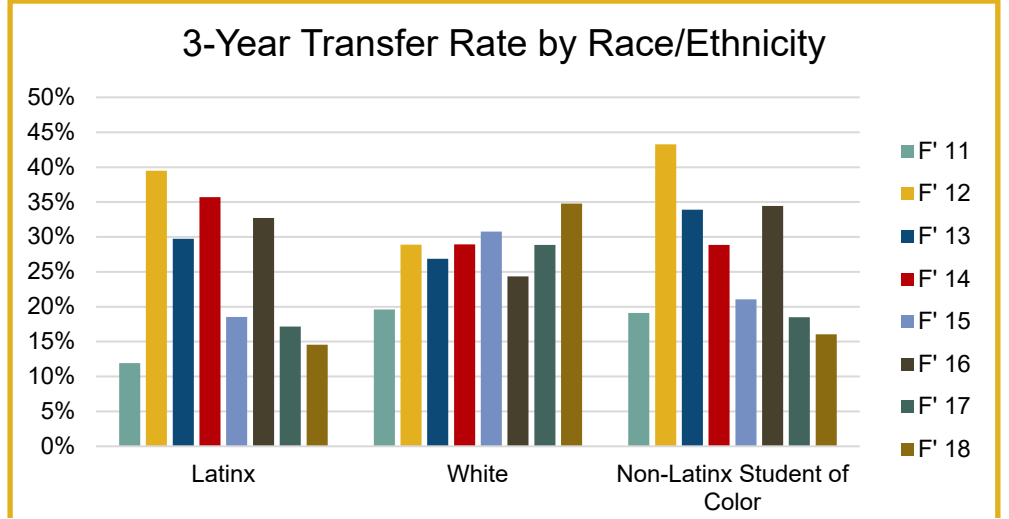
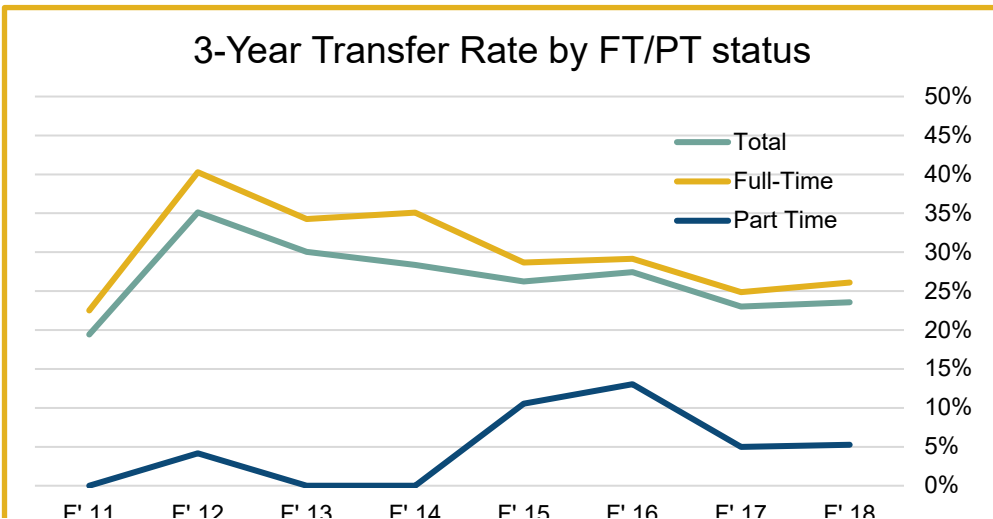
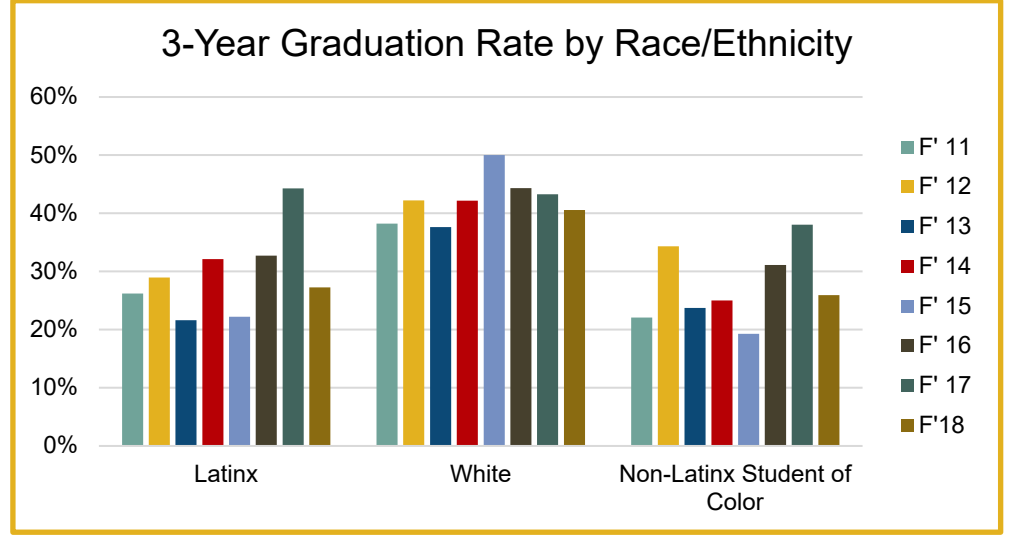
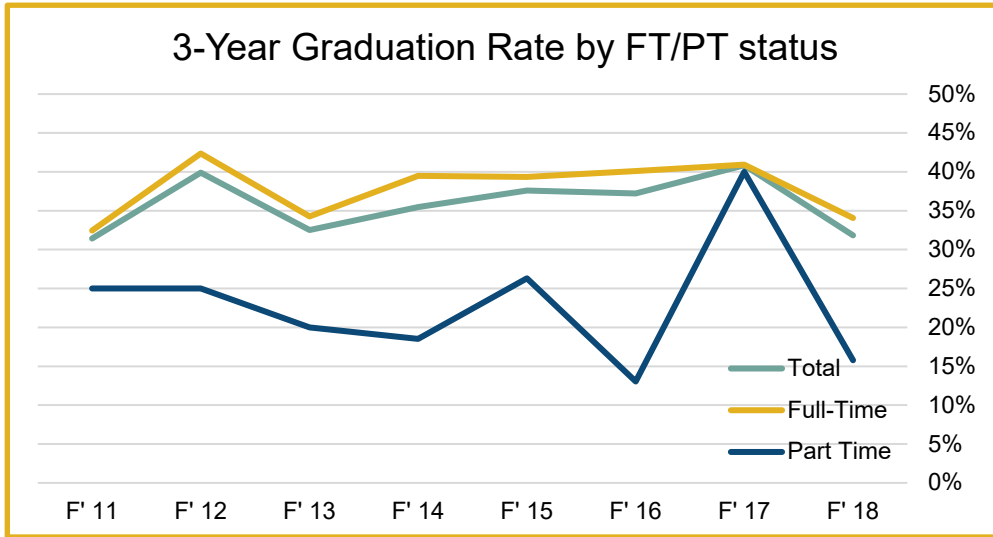
Data Definitions:
