**ARP Distribution Plan/Quarterly Report**

LCC acknowledges that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA (a)(1) and (a)(4) ARP program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

LCC determined a pay structure to distribute the remaining \$421,868.00 in ARP funding for students during the Spring Semester 2022. The pay structure used is below:

Eligible students with an expected family contribution (EFC) of \$0-5,999 will receive \$1500. Students with an EFC of \$6000-69,999 will receive \$1250, students with an EFC of \$70,000 – \$89,999 will receive \$1,000, and those with an EFC of \$90,000 - \$100,000+ will receive \$750.

Eligible students who have not completed the federal aid application or do not fall into one of these EFC categories will be awarded \$250.

As of April 1, 2022 we have spent our allocated CRRSAA funding. We have spent \$867,230 of our ARP funding. We were able to award 384 students based on the EFC chart.

We will be awarding the remaining ARP funding in the amount of \$47,743 to the Nursing students who attend clinicals in the Spring Semester.
