Community members, students, local business leaders, and the general public are invited to attend. Guests will have the opportunity to tour the facility, view live equipment demonstrations, and learn more about how the space can support product development and entrepreneurship.

This strategic partnership combines LCC's academic resources with the SBDC's entrepreneurial expertise to foster innovation and small business growth across Southeast Colorado. By uniting advanced fabrication tools with professional business consulting, the Innovate and Makerspace provides students, community members, and aspiring entrepreneurs with the resources needed to transform ideas into market-ready products.

- Laser Cutting & Engraving: Precision fabrication for wood, acrylic, and leather
- Professional Sewing & Textile Lab: Industrial sewing machines for heavy-duty materials and a long-arm quilting machine for large-scale textile and artistic projects
